NARROW MACRAME WALL HANGER

Macrame knots used in the project

Half knot HK picture 1 Square knot SK picture 2 Single half hitch knot SHHK picture 3

Design Lankava Oy, Annikki Orrenmaa

Technique Macrame

Finished size 25 x 110 cm + fringes

Yarn 1 kg of Paulina Chunky Twine (80% recycled cotton, 20% polyester) in desired color

Other supplies 35 cm long wooden rod

Instructions Cut 20 x 8.5 m lengths of the Paulina twine. Fold the lengths in half and attach to the rod with lark's head knots. Check that the ends are at even length.

The wall hanger is made of 4 rows of alternating twists made with HKs (made 4 times), and "columns" made with SKs (3 times).

1) Skip 2 threads, make 9 HK, skip 2 threads.

2) Alternating twists:

Row 1: Make 10 twists, each are made with 8 HKs.

Row 2: Make 3 pairs of SHHK with the first 2 threads, make 9 twists (each has 8 HK), 3 pairs of SHHK with the last 2 threads. Repeat rows 1 & 2 once more.

3) First row of columns:

Make 10 columns, each have 9 SKs.

4) Second section of alternating twists:

As in 2), but begin with Row 2, then make Row 1. Repeat Rows 2 & 1 once more.

5) Second row of colums:

Make 7 pairs of SHHK with the first 2 threads, make 9 columns (each has 9 SK), 7 pairs of SHHK with the last 2 threads.

6) Third section of alternating twists:

Make as the first section of alternating twists in 2).

7) Third row of columns:

Make as the first row of columns in 3).


8) Fourth section of alternating twists:


Make as the second section of alternating twists in 4).

Binding off: Make a pair of SHHK with the first 2 threads, 9 HKs with the middle threads, a pair of SHHK with the last 2 threads.

Finishing: Cut the ends to even length.







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
