

MINI KNIT CUSHION COVERS

Design: Lankava, Marja Rautiainen.

Size: 38 x 38 cm.

Yarn: Lankava Mini Tube Yarn (80 % recycled cotton, 20 % polyester, 1 kg = approx. 355 m) 450 g petrol (27), yellow (7) and milk chocolate (5).

Other supplies: Zipper 35 cm and inner cushion 40 x 40 cm.

Needles: 3–4 and 5 mm, or size to obtain gauge.

Gauge: 12.5 sts and 18 rows = 10 cm using larger needle.

Abbreviations: *BO* = bind off, *CO* = cast on, *K* = knit, *P* = purl, *RS* = right side, *sl* = slip, *st(s)* = stitch(es), *WS* = wrong side

YELLOW CUSHION

Work flat in rows following the written instructions and the chart. The stitch count is divisible by 2 + 2 sts (1 extra st at each edge). Always slip the first st and purl the last st of the row.

Using larger needle, CO 48 sts.

Row 1 (RS): K1, *P1, K1*, repeat *-* 22 times more, P1.

Rows 2-3 (WS): Sl1, *P1, K1*, repeat *-* 22 times more, P1.

Rows 4-6: Sl1, *K1, P1*, repeat *-* 22 times more, P1.

Continue following the chart and repeat Rows 1-6, 10 times more and end by working Rows 1-3 = 69 rows. Check that the height and width of the piece match with each other. BO as usual and leave a tail of approx. 50 cm at the end for sewing the side seam.

Next, pick up 48 sts from the bottom edge using the smaller needle, and then using larger needle, K48 from RS of the work. Turn work and begin working in Moss Stitch starting from Row 4, and again, work 69 rows. Leave a tail of 50 cm at the end for sewing the other side seam.

Finishing: With the right sides of the pieces facing each other, sew the side seams. Turn the cover and sew the zipper in place to the top edge by hand.

Any commercial use of this pattern is prohibited.

PETROL CUSHION

Work flat in rows following the written instructions and the chart. Always slip the first st and purl the last st of the row. The stitch count is divisible by 4 + 2 sts (1 extra st at each edge).

Using larger needle, CO 46 sts.

Row 1: K1, *K2, P2*, repeat *-* to last st, P1. You now have 3 knit sts at the beginning and 3 purl sts at the end of the row.

Rows 2-3: Sl1, *K2, P2*, repeat *-* 10 times more, P1.

Rows 4-6: Sl1, *P2, K2*, repeat *-* to last st, P1.

Continue following the chart and repeat Rows 1-6, 10 times more. End by working Rows 1-2 = 68 rows.

Check that the height and width of the piece match with each other. BO as usual and leave a tail of approx. 50 cm at the end for sewing the side seam. Next, pick up 46 sts from the cast-on edge using the smaller needle and then using larger needle, K48 from WS of the work. Turn work and begin working in pattern starting from Row 1, and again, work 68 rows. Leave a tail of 50 cm at the end for sewing the other side seam.

Finishing: With the right sides of the pieces facing each other, sew the side seams. Turn the cover and sew the zipper in place to the top edge by hand.

MILK CHOCOLATE CUSHION

Work in the round following the written instructions and the chart. The st count is divisible by 4.

Using larger needle, CO 92 sts.

Rnds 1-2: *P1, K3*, repeat *-* to end.

Rnds 3-4: *K1, P1*, repeat *-*.

Rnds 5-6: K2, *P1, K3*, repeat *-*, P1, K1.

Rnds 7-8: As Rnd 3. Repeat Rnds 1-8 until the height matches with the width of the piece and you have last worked Rnd 6. Then, BO as usual. Leave a tail of approx. 50 cm at the end for sewing.

Finishing: Turn the cover inside out and sew the opposite sts of the bind-off edge together. Weave in the tail end. Turn the cover and sew the zipper in place to the bottom edge by hand.
