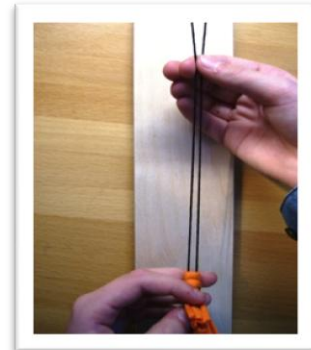
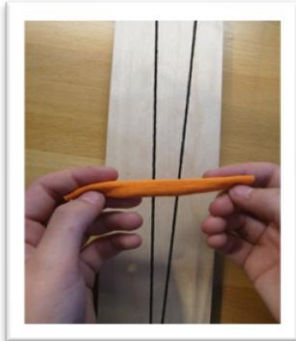




KNOT MAKER

FOR MAKING A RYA KNOT -BAND

The knot maker comes with the warp yarns ready, so that you can directly try it. The rya knot -band can be used to make wreaths, accessories, seat covers or small rugs, for example. You can use different types of yarns for the warp. Notice that if the yarn is stretchy, you may need to tighten the warp yarns as you work.

Start by cutting pieces of yarn for the rya knots. Work as in the pictures above: make a rya knot, tighten it and pull the knot towards you. When the working length of the warp is full, release the warp yarns by taking the blue pegs off by twisting them. Lift off the nail at the other end, and move the work, so that you can put the nail back, after the last knot you have made. Tighten the warp yarns again and secure them with the blue pegs. If you are using a thin or a slippery warp yarn, put another yarn through the holes to secure the warp yarns better, or, try the spare pegs included.
