## ASTER RUG

Design: Lankava Oy, Marjukka Tyrväinen
Finished size: Diameter approx. 110 cm
Yarn: 2.7 kg of Esteri tube yarn (100\% PES, $1 \mathrm{~kg}=\mathrm{ap}-$ prox. 330 m ), in lime (5)
Hook: 7-8 mm (US L/11), or according to personal gauge
US crochet terms used throughout. Abbreviations: st(s) $=$ stitch(es), ch = chain, sc = single crochet, dc = double crochet, $\mathrm{tr}=$ treble, sl st = slip stitch

Instructions: Begin with a magic loop (= twist yarn around finger, take hook through loop, pick up yarn with the hook, yarn over and pull through the loop on hook).
Round 1: Crochet into the magic loop: Ch 3 (counts as $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{dc}$ ), 11 dc , close with a sl st in the $3^{\text {rd }} \mathrm{ch}=12 \mathrm{dc}$. Close all rounds with a sl st, unless otherwise instructed.
Rnd 2: Ch 3, 1 dc in same st as chain, 2 dc in each st = 24 dc .
Rnd 3: Ch 3, 2 dc in next st, *dc in next st, 2 dc in next st*$^{*}$, repeat *-* 10 more times $=36 \mathrm{dc}$.
Rnd 4: Ch 3, dc in next st, 2 dc in next st, *dc in next 2 sts , 2 dc in next st*, repeat *-* 10 more times $=48 \mathrm{dc}$.


Rnd 5: Ch 3, dc in each st = 48 dc .
Rnd 6: Ch 3, dc, ch 2, 2 dc in next st, skip next 2 sts, *2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc in next st, skip next 2 sts*, repeat *-* 14 more times.
Rnd 7: SI st in the dc, sl st in the $1^{\text {st }}$ st of the ch3, then in the ch-2space: ch 3, dc, ch 3,2 dc. *In the next ch-2 space: 2 dc , ch $3,2 \mathrm{dc}^{*}$, repeat *-* 14 more times.
Rnd 8: SI st in the dc, sl st in the $1^{\text {st }}$ st of the ch3, then in the ch-3 space: ch $3,2 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 3,3 \mathrm{dc}$. *In the next ch-3 space: 3 dc , ch $3,3 \mathrm{dc}^{*}$, repeat *-* 14 more times.
Rnd 9: Move with 3 slsts to the $1^{\text {st }}$ st of the ch space, *sc in the ch-3 space, ch 3 , dc in the space between the dcgroups, ch $3^{*}$, repeat *-* 15 more times.
Rnd 10: Ch 3, 3 dc in the ch-3 space, dc in the dc from previous round, 3 dc in the ch-3 space, *dc in the next sc, 3 dc in the ch-3 space, dc in the dc, 3 dc in the ch-3 space*, repeat *-* 14 more times.
Rnds 11-13: Ch 3, dc in each st = 128 dc .
Rnd 14: Ch 3, dc, ch 3, 2 dc in the next st, skip 3 sts, *2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc in the next st, skip 2 sts*, repeat *-* 39 more times, 2 dc , ch 3, 2 dc in the next st, skip 3 sts.
Rnds 15-17: SI st in dc, sl st in $1^{\text {st }}$ ch, in the ch-2 space: ch 3 , dc, ch 2,2 dc, *in the next ch-2 space: $2 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 2,2$ dc*, repeat *-* 40 more times.
Rnd 18: SI st in dc, sl st in $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{ch}$, in the ch-2 space: Ch $3,2 \mathrm{dc}$, ch $3,3 \mathrm{dc}$, *in the next ch-2 space: $3 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 2,3$ dc*, repeat *-* 40 more times.
Rnd 19: Move with 2 sl sts to the $1^{\text {st }}$ st of the ch- 2 , *sc in the ch- 2 space, ch 2 , dc in between the dc-groups, ch $2^{*}$, repeat *-* 41 more times.
Rnd 20: Ch 3, 2 dc in the ch-2 space, dc in the dc from previous round, 2 dc in the ch- 2 space, *dc in the sc, 2 dc in the ch-2 space, dc in the dc, 2 dc in the ch- 2 space*, repeat *-* 40 more times.
Rnd 21: Ch 3, dc in each st = 252 dc.
Rnd 22: Ch 3, dc in each st, but increase 4 sts with even intervals by making 2 dc in the same st = 256 dc .
Rnd 23: Ch 3, dc in each st = 256 dc. Next round begins the lace edge.
Rnd 24: Ch 4, $\operatorname{tr}$, ch 2 , 2 tr in the same st, skip 3 sts, * 2 tr , ch $2,2 \mathrm{tr}$ in the next st, skip 3 sts*, repeat *** till the end of round, sl st in the $4^{\text {th }} \mathrm{ch}$.
Rnd 25: SI st in the tr, sl st in the ch-space, in the ch-2 space: ch 4,6 tr, in the next ch-2 space: sc, *in the next ch-2 space: 7 tr , in the next ch-2 space: $\mathrm{sc}^{*}$, repeat *-* till the end of round, sl st in the $4^{\text {th }} \mathrm{ch}$.
Finishing: Weave in yarn ends and steam the finished rug from the wrong side.
Care: Delicate wash, stretch to measurements when wet, dry flat. Let possible stains soak before washing.
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
