

AINO RAG RUG

Design: Lankava, Marja Rautiainen

Finished size: 72 x 200 cm

Weave structure: plain weave

Warp/ meter: 85 g of Liina Cotton Twine, 15-ply, in Undyed (1) (tex 30x15, 100% cotton, 500 g/roll or 1.8 kg/cone).

- width: 80 cm
- threads/cm: 2
- reed: 20/1
- total threads: 160+2

Weft/ 1 rug: Aino Rag Rug Yarn: 1.6 kg in Blue shades (3), 0.8 kg in Red shades (5), and 0.7 kg in Yellow shades (6) (100% cotton, width: 25 mm, 1-2 kg/package)

Weft threads/ cm: 2-3

Instructions: Double the edge threads, i.e. put 2 warp threads in the first and last heddle. Begin and end the rug by weaving a couple of shots with the cotton twine. Use one shuttle to weave the rug. Repeat the following striping 4 times: 11 cm in blue, 11 cm in red, 11 cm in blue, 11 cm in yellow. End with 11 cm in blue, 11 cm in red, and 11 cm in blue = 209 cm. When you meet a seam in the weft, cut the seam off and cut the weft ends diagonally. Place the ends in the same shed, overlapping each other and continue to weave as before.

Finishing: Make fringes with 4-thread overhand knots. Make each fringe into a twisted fringe with 2+2 threads. Secure the end of each twisted fringe with a tight overhand knot. Cut ends to even length.



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
