CORNER RUG

US crochet terms used throughout. Abbreviations: st(s) = stitch(es) ch = chain sl st = slip stitch dc = double crochet

Design: Lankava, Molla Mills **Finished size:** diameter 120 cm

Yarn: Loopy Craft Yarn Frotee: 1,2 kg in Mint (59), and 2,4 kg in Light purple (85) (80% recycled cotton, 20%

polyester, 1,2 kg = approx. 220 m)

Hook: 10 mm (US N/P), or according to personal gauge

Gauge: 4 rounds = 10 cm

Tapestry crochet: This rug is worked in the round with dcs, using two colors. Take the other yarn into the work and start tapestry crochet on round 9. Always change color so that you make the last yarn over of the previous st with the new color. Keep both yarns at an even tension throughout the work, and check that the yarn running inside the sts is not too loose.

Instructions: Make the rug in tapestry crochet with 2 colors, according to the chart.

Round 1: With the Light purple: Make a magic loop and crochet into the loop: Ch 3, 17 dc, close with a sl st into the 3rd ch = 18 dc. Continue working with just the Light purple.

Rnd 2: Ch 3+ dc into the first st, *dc in next st, 2 dc in next st, ch 1, 2 dc in next st*, repeat *-* 5 more times, 2 dc in next st, ch 1, close with a sl st into the 3rd ch = 30 dc

Rnd 3: Ch 3+ dc into the first st, *dc in next 3 sts, 2 dc in next st, ch 1, skip ch-1 space from previous rnd, 2 dc in next st*, repeat *-* 5 more times, 2 dc next st, ch 1, close with a sl st into the 3rd ch = 42 dc.

Continue to work according to the chart and begin tapestry crochet with 2 colors on rnd 9. To finish, cut the yarns and weave in ends.


