## VUOKKO POSTER

DESIGN: Lankava, Molla Mills.
SIZE: W. 66 cm , h. 103 cm .
YARN: Moi Braided Yarn (80 \% recycled CO, 20 \% PES, $500 \mathrm{~g}=300 \mathrm{~m}) 900 \mathrm{~g}$ pale blue (76), 500 g white (51), 350 g dark green (61).
HOOK: $4,5 \mathrm{~mm}$ (or size to obtain gauge).
GAUGE: $14 \mathrm{sc} \times 12$ rows $=10 \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}$.
OTHER: Cotton ribbon (w. 30 mm l .70 cm ).
INFO: The poster is worked back and forth in single crochet stitches, carrying the other yarns inside the stitches throughout the work. Change the color of the yarn in the last yarn over of the stitch. Leave the carry-on yarns one stitch from the end at the backside of the work on each row to make sure the yarn loops won't show on the right side of the work.

## ABBREVIATIONS:

ch = chain stitch
$s=$ stitch
$s c=$ single crochet stitch (Am.)
sl st = slip stitch
START: Row 1. Work 93 ch in pale blue yarn, leave a 6 m long yarn tail for the sl st row. Work 1 $s c$ in the second st from the hook, grab the other yarns in the work, work 91 sc . Leave the carry-on yarns one st from the end on the backside of the work.
Rows 2.-8. Work 1 ch, turn, grab the other yarns in the work. Note! The starting ch counts as the
 first sc of each row. Work 1 sc in each st.
Row 9 . Work 1 ch, turn, grab the other yarns in the work. Work 40 sc in pale blue yarn, change to dark green yarn, work 9 sc. Change to pale blue yarn and work 42 sc.
Rows 10.-124. Continue the work according to the pattern chart.
Cut white and dark green yarns and weave in ends. Work a sl st row in a pale blue yarn on the top edge of the work. Cut yarn and weave in ends.
Work a sl st row at the bottom of the work with the pale blue yarn tail. Cut yarn and weave in ends.
FINISHING: Sew a cotton ribbon on the top edge at the backside of the work by hand.
