

BRIOCHE SCARF

Design: Lankava, Sanna Peltoluhta

Size: 29 x 180 cm

Yarn: Lankava Villava Wool Yarn 2-ply (100 % Finnish wool, 100 g = 270 m) 200 g natural white (1) and 200 g beige (6).

Needles: 4 mm circular needle 60 cm or 80 cm or size to obtain gauge, Cable needle

Brioche Stitch: In Two-Color Brioche Stitch, each row is worked twice. First, work the entire row with beige yarn, then slide the stitches back to the beginning of the needle and the same row is worked again with natural white yarn. These two rows worked with different colors, A and B, count as one row. In Brioche Stitch, both sides of the fabric look otherwise the same, but on the right side the natural white color dominates, and on the wrong side the beige color dominates.

Gauge: 18 sts and 22 rows = 10 cm. Make a swatch and change needle size if necessary to obtain the recommended gauge.

Abbreviations:

Brk = Brioche knit: Knit a stitch and its yarn over together

Brp = Brioche purl: Purl a stitch and its yarn over together

K = Knit

P = Purl

RS = Right side of work

Sl = Slip

Sl1yo = sl1 purlwise wyif bringing yarn over the needle

St(s) = Stitch(es)

WS = Wrong side of work

Wyif = With yarn in front

Yo = Yarn over



Instructions: Using natural white yarn, cast on 58 sts. **Row 1A (RS):** In beige yarn, P1, *sl1yo (= sl1 purlwise wyif bringing yarn over the needle), P1*, repeat *-* 27 times more, P1. Slide the sts back to the beginning of the needle.

Row 1B (RS): In natural white yarn, sl1 purlwise, *brk, sl1yo*, repeat *-* 27 times more and then, sl1 purlwise. Turn work. **Row 2A (WS):** In beige yarn. sl1 knitwise (= as if to knit), *brk, sl1yo*, repeat *-* 27 times more, K1. Slide the sts back to the beginning of the needle. **Row 2B (WS):** In natural white yarn, sl1 purlwise, *sl1yo, brp*, repeat *-* 27 times more, leave the yarn hanging in front of the work and then, sl1 purlwise. Turn work. **Row 3A (RS):**

In beige yarn, sl1 purlwise, *sl1yo, brp*, repeat *-* 27 times more, P1. Slide the sts back to the beginning of the needle. **Row 3B (RS):** In natural white, as Row 1B. Repeat Rows 2A, 2B, 3A, 3B, 2A and 2B. Then, work the first cable row. **Row 7A:** In beige yarn, sl1 purlwise, then work a brioche cable as follows: **Sl 4 sts on the cable needle in front of work (= 1 st, 1 st+yo, 1 st, 1 st+yo) *sl1yo, brp*, repeat *-* once more, then work sts on cable needle by repeating *-* 2 times. Work next 8 sts by repeating *-* 4 times**, then repeat **-* 2 times more. Finish by working a brioche cable as before and then, P1. **Row 7B:** As Row 1B. Then, repeat Rows 2A, 2B, 3A ja 3B 2 times more. Finish by working Rows 2A and 2B. Then, work another brioche cable row. **Row 13A:** In beige yarn, Sl1 purlwise, *sl1yo, brp*, repeat *-* 3 times more, then work a brioche cable as follows: **Sl 4 sts on the cable needle in front of work (= 1 st, 1 st+yo, 1 st, 1 st+yo), repeat *-* 2 times more, then work sts on cable needle by repeating *-* 2 times. Work next 8 sts by repeating *-* 4 times**, then repeat **-* 2 times more, P1. **Row 13B:** As Row 1B. Repeat Rows 2 – 13 until scarf measures 175 - 180 cm and you have last worked Row 7. Then, repeat Rows 2 – 3, 3 times more. Bind off using natural white yarn.

Finishing: Weave in ends. Gently squeezing hand-wash the finished scarf in lukewarm water using wool-detergent. Rinse thoroughly and add a drop of fabric softener in the last rinse water. Do not dose detergents excessively. Lay the scarf flat in measurements on a flat surface.
