

HAMAM HAIR TOWEL

Design: Lankava, Mia Lehtiniemi.

Finished size: 59x95 cm.

Structure: Broken twill.

Warp/m: 90 g 1/2-Bleached (2001) Bockens Nialin 22/2, tex 80x2 (60 % cotton, 40 % linen, 250 g = approx. 1650 m).

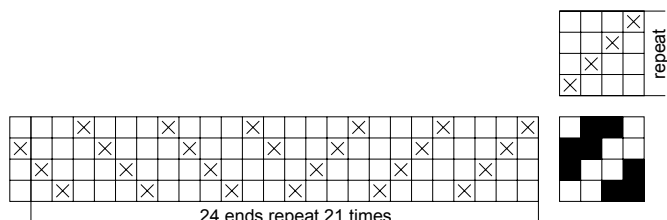
- width: 63 cm
- sett: 8 ends per cm
- reed: 2 per dent in a 40-dent reed
- 505 ends total

Weft/towel: 75 g Golden Brown (2010), 75 g Light red-brown (2016), 75 g Blue-Green (2032) and 20 g 1/2-Bleached (2001) Bockens Nialin, tex 80x2.

Sett: 8 picks per cm.

Weaving: Weave three 100 cm long towels with different weft colours. While following the treadling draft, weave the stripes in the following colour order: 10 cm coloured, 12 picks (= 1,5 cm) bleached, 12 picks coloured, 5 cm bleached, 12 picks coloured and 12 picks bleached (= 21 cm). Weave the middle area with coloured thread for 58 cm. Mirror the striped beginning in the following way: 12 picks bleached, 12 picks coloured, 5 cm bleached, 12 picks coloured, 12 picks bleached and 10 cm coloured = 100 cm. Leave 30 cm between the pieces for the fringes.

Finishing: Cut the pieces apart in the middle of the unwoven parts. Prepare a twisted fringe with 3 + 3 ends and trim the ends of the fringes below the knots.



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
